The motto of the Holy Family School is: In Prayer, Love & Work: Peace.

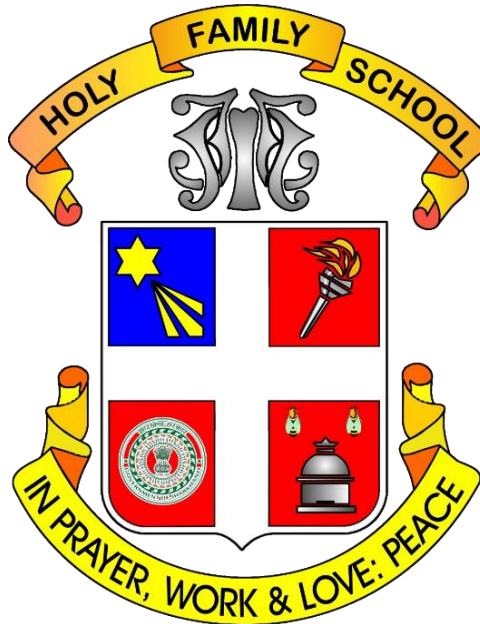

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL

The educational aim of our School is oriented mainly to the achievement of the following aims:

- a) The full development of the personality of the student, in his / her individual, social and transcendent aspect.
- b) The formation in the respect for the fundamental rights and liberties and in the exercise of tolerance and freedom with in the democratic principles of coexistence.
- c) The acquisition of intellectual habits and techniques of work, as well as scientific, humanistic, religious, moral, historical and aesthetic knowledge.
- d) The capacitation for the exercise of professional activities.
- e) The formation for the respect of linguistic, cultural, and religious plurality in India.
- f) The preparation for participating actively in the social and cultural life in a responsible and constructive way.
- g) The formation for peace, cooperation and solidarity among the nations.
- h) The education for the respect and conservation of nature as a common good of all the humanity.
- i) The synthesis between faith, culture and life
- j) The integral and harmonic development of the personality of the students in their different aspects: corporal, affective, social, intellectual, moral and religious.

ROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

1. Generally new admissions (Nursery, 80 seats) to Holy Family School are taken only in the month of January. Admission to other classes depends on vacancies available, and from 1st Standard on wards is also based on tests in the standard immediately below that for which admission is sought for.

2. Once a child has been accepted for admission, the parents should fill in the application form for admission with most care.
4. Signature of both parents must be given on the application form for admission either signature will be valid for all transactions while the candidate continues to study.
5. The signing of the application form for admission constitutes undertaking by the parents that they abide by the rules governing the school. Parents should also sign an Educational Contract with the School.
6. New candidates must be introduced personally by the parents. The later will be responsible for the fees and also for the conduct and studies of their children.
7. Proper certificate with the name of the candidate must be submitted along with copies. No affidavit will be accepted. A birth certificate must be produced from Nagar Panchayat; Christian students must also present a Certificate of Baptism.
8. A candidate who has attended a recognized school must present a Transfer Certificate (TC) from the school he/she last attended.
9. One may be considered admitted only after the payment of all dues required at the time of admission. Subsequent withdrawal or non-attendance on required day will mean the cancellation of the admission and no refund will be made.
10. Transport is available, it is independent of admission.
11. The Principal is the final authority in all matters of admission.

FEE REGULATIONS

1. The school fees cover twelve calendar months.
2. No reduction is made for holidays or strikes bands, Covid, lockdown curfew broken periods any is at the decision of Management.
3. All fees are payable at the school Administration Office between 9.00 am to 12.30 pm, during the school time from Monday to Saturday. Payment through Bank is also available (further information in school Administration office).
4. **Last day for acceptance of school fees is the 25th of the month. Late fees deposit: The fine of rupees 100/- (one hundred rupees only) will be charged with the fees of the month up to the 30th of the months.**
5. February and March fees are to be paid together before 15th of February; and likewise, November and December fees are to be paid together by 15th of November.
6. **Name of the defaulter will be struck off the rolls after nonpayment of the fees for four months as per rules above without any further intimation to the concerned.**
7. Enrolment may be accepted on payment of admission with the permission of the Principal.
8. The School reserves the right to increase the fees at any time of the year, if an increment is considered necessary by the Managing Committee of the Society.

Recognizing that mere book learning is insufficient for a well-rounded life, Holy Family School places a strong emphasis on the holistic development of students. Special attention is given to nurturing their personality, initiative, and originality through a variety of creative cocurricular activities, both individually and collectively.

In addition to the core subjects like Science, Mathematics, and Computer Studies, the school curriculum at Holy Family School also encompasses Hindi, Sanskrit, English, and Social Studies. Furthermore, the curriculum includes Art, Catechism/Value Education, Life Skills, and General Knowledge. Drills and Games form an essential part of the Physical and Health Education program.

By fostering a balanced educational experience, Holy Family School prepares students to navigate the complexities of the world with confidence and competence.

HOUSE SYSTEM

ASSESSMENT AND PROMOTION

1. Promotion at the end of the year will be based on attendance, continuous assessment in every subject, work done during the year and over all conduct record.
2. Unit Tests, Class Tests and Assignments are given regularly during each term and certain percentage of marks are allotted for them. There will be Term Examinations in August and December and the Final Examination in March. For promotion to the next class, a minimum of 40% marks in each subject is required for all classes.
3. First Term exam papers will be shown in to the parents but the script of the Annual examination will not under any circumstances be shown to the guardians or private tutor.
4. For the students who are absent for any assessment no provision can be made for supplementary tests.
5. If a student is unable to appear for any examination due to illness, medical certificate has to be produced to this effect. This will, however, have no claim over promotion. If the absence is justified, the fact will be taken in to account at the end of the school year.
6. Progress reports is issued after Term Examinations are to be countersigned by the parents and returned to the School on the day notified. Defaulters may be penalized through a fine or may not be allowed to attend school until the report is collected/returned.
7. Regular attendance in class is a condition for promotion. A student will not be promoted to the next higher class if his/her attendance is below 75%. Condonation is exercised only in exceptionally valid cases that to only to the extent of 10% shortage.
8. The breach of any regulations of conduct at examination sort he use of unfair means, even if discovered subsequently, will result in the cancellation of the particular paper; the student concerned will be added zero and he/she will be expelled from the entire examination (all subjects).
9. The result of the Final Assessment is final and cannot be changed.
10. A student failing in his/her class at the end of the year does not remain on the rolls unless the Parents/Guardians notify the Principal in advance that they wish their son/daughter to continue his/her studies in the School.
11. The Principal's decision in matters of promotion is final and binding.

12. The students are graded in their work as follows:-

SCHOOL RULES

1. The school day commences with a prayer at the Morning Assembly and all the students and teachers must be on time for it.
2. It is compulsory for every student to be present on the reopening and closing day of the school after vacation and on days marked "Attendance Compulsory otherwise they are fined". The only exception to the above rule will be ill-health of the student, in which case it should be notified to the school authorities within two days and not when the student comes back to school. Failing to do so the name of the student will be struck off the register.
3. Every student must have the copy of the School Diary, which must be brought to school every day. A student will not be allowed to sit in the class without the School Diary.
4. Student who are absent from class must have the reason entered in the *Regularity Record*, stating briefly the cause of absence. The statement must be written and signed by parents/guardians. Reasons of private nature must be submitted in a letter.
5. An absence due to illness for two or more days, besides being entered in the Regularity Record under "Absent" must be accompanied by a doctor's prescription.
6. If an unauthorised absence from the school exceeds 15 days, the student's name may be struck off the rolls, or fined 1000 rupees and he/she may not be readmitted to the school.
7. Absence from school without leave is not tolerated except when the cause is sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances, in which case information must be given at the earliest. A leave granted must be recorded in the Regularity Record "Leave" in the school diary. This must be signed by the Principal.
8. Leave of absence is not given without a previous written application from the Parents/Guardians stating the reasons, which must be serious one. Religious ceremonies, birthdays, excursions, festivals, urgent business, time to study for an examination, late return from holidays... are not valid or sufficient reasons for absence from the School.
9. Late arrival to school is a breach of discipline. A student who comes late to school must enter the date and time of arrival in the Regularity Record under "Late". Admission to class for absentees and latecomers is granted when they show the teacher in-charge the Regularity Record duly counter signed by the Principal.
10. Habitual late coming or coming to school with improper/incomplete uniform may call for disciplinary action inclusive of being sent back home and on such occasion the School detain all responsibility for the student's safe return.
11. Once in the School, the students will not be allowed to leave the campus without the authorization of the Principal, who will require the written request from the parents to take a child out. The 'exit pass' must be

noted in the School Diary; for security reasons, no one other than the parents or the person authorised by them can take the child out of the School.

12. Students must bring their own 'Tiffin Box' and should avoid buying 'tiffin' from shops around the School. The School is not responsible for the food sold by these vendors.
13. Any kind of scribbling on the walls, damaging the property of the School, misappropriation of the things belonging to others, etc. are considered serious faults. Besides, the damages must be made up for by the student concerned from the school.
14. Students should come to School in full uniform. They must look clean and tidy, Whenever the correct and complete uniform cannot be worn, permission to attend school must be obtained on the Regularity Record under "Uniform". (Haircut & Nailcut)
15. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their own books and belongings. Each article should be marked with the student's name, especially for the younger students.
16. During the change of periods or when going from one class to another, silence must be observed.
17. Students are to address their teachers and all members of the school staff with due respect and their behaviour inside and outside the school should be befitting.
18. Holy Family students should also be polite among themselves speaking gently to one another and behaving at all times in a friendly and loving manner.
19. No collections or fines or funds are to be made in the School without explicit permission of the principal.
20. No remarks once written in the School Diary can be cancelled by any other rather than the Principal.

WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSALS

1. For withdrawal from School a written application signed by both parents/guardians is required.
2. No Transfer Certificate (TC) will be given to any student who leaves the school unless all outstanding fees have been settled.
3. As a rule, a student will not be allowed to repeat the same class for a third time nor will a student be permitted to repeat two classes in three consecutive years.
4. Two general remarks given for serious breach of discipline can be as deterrent to promotion or even dismissal from the School.
5. As a rule, a student who is dismissed or whose Transfer certificate has been taken will not be readmitted.

The Principal's decision is final in all cases of dismissal or withdrawal.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

There are certain behaviours for which the students may automatically incur a detention or suspension or even dismissal at the discretion of the Principal. Certain objectionable behaviour are the following:-

1. Cheating in an examination.
2. Rudeness to a staff member.
3. Writing or deliberately spoiling the school furniture, equipment, or the library books.
4. "Bunking" of Class.
5. Using obscene or vulgar language or acting in an indecent manner.
6. Being absent from the school without prior permission from the Principal and the teacher concerned.
7. Lack of co-operation in the school activities.
8. Dishonesty of any sort.
9. Any form of stealing.
10. Regularly not doing the homework or the class assignments.

SCHOOL HOURS

1. School timing: 8.30am to 2.30pm. Every Saturday classes will finish at 12.30pm. Lost class day may be made up on other days.
2. School Office hour: 9.00am to 12.30am. On Monday to Saturday.
3. The Principal is available from 9.00am to 10.30am or by previous appointment at Reception.
4. No school business will be transacted on Sundays, Holidays or during vacations.
5. Winter and Summer timetable will change.

PARENTAL ATTENTION

1. Parents retain the rights and duties in the education of their children, though they delegate them in part to the School. The collaboration of the parents is essential in the work of education carried on in the School. (See Pastoral activities that Holy Family School offers for the participation of the parents.)
2. Ordinary communication with parents is carried out through the circulars issued to the whole school, section of the school or classes, and through the School Diary.
3. All communication with the School should be addressed to the Principal and through the School Diary or Reception preferably. These should be carefully read and instruction followed.
4. Letters sent to the parents should be promptly responded. Parents when summoned to School must understand that there is something very important to be discussed with them.
5. Parents and students are discouraged strongly from giving any kind of gifts to teachers/members of the staff. They are also discouraged from visiting the school staff in their residences except in an emergency.
6. The parents are not allowed to meet the teachers in the month of February and during the class periods.
7. As a general principles parents should not give to their children whatever they want, but what they need.
8. Parents are requested not to allow small children to wear ornaments or carry cash with them, as they may not be able to take care of them. Students are not allowed to wear digital or smart watch.
9. Admittance to the school premises is at the discretion of the school authorities, who reserve to themselves the right to refuse admission to anyone without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 10. Parents harassing a teacher of Holy Family School in the outside the school for favours or for their children may be asked to withdraw their children from School.**
11. Parents are requested to cooperate with the school authorities in particular:
 - a. By discussing with the principal and/or teachers the progress of their children and when required. Parents and Guardians are always welcome to the School to discuss any problem of their children at the time fixed for such meeting or at other times by previous appointment.
 - b. By urging the students to be punctual and regular in attendance.
 - c. By seeing that the children are diligent in their work and lessons, project work and other assignments.
 - d. By attending the parents-teacher meetings organized by the school.
12. Every precaution is taken to avoid accidents. Nevertheless, should an accident occur, the School will not be responsible for any injury sustained by the student. If hospitalization becomes necessary, it may be done even before the parents can be informed.
13. Parents should be living examples of the values taught to and expected of their children. They should inform the Principal and the teachers concerned of any family problem or other pertinent facts that are necessary for a proper understanding and guidance of the children.
14. A record of Address and Mobile No. of parents is maintained in the School. Any change should be communicated to the School Reception.

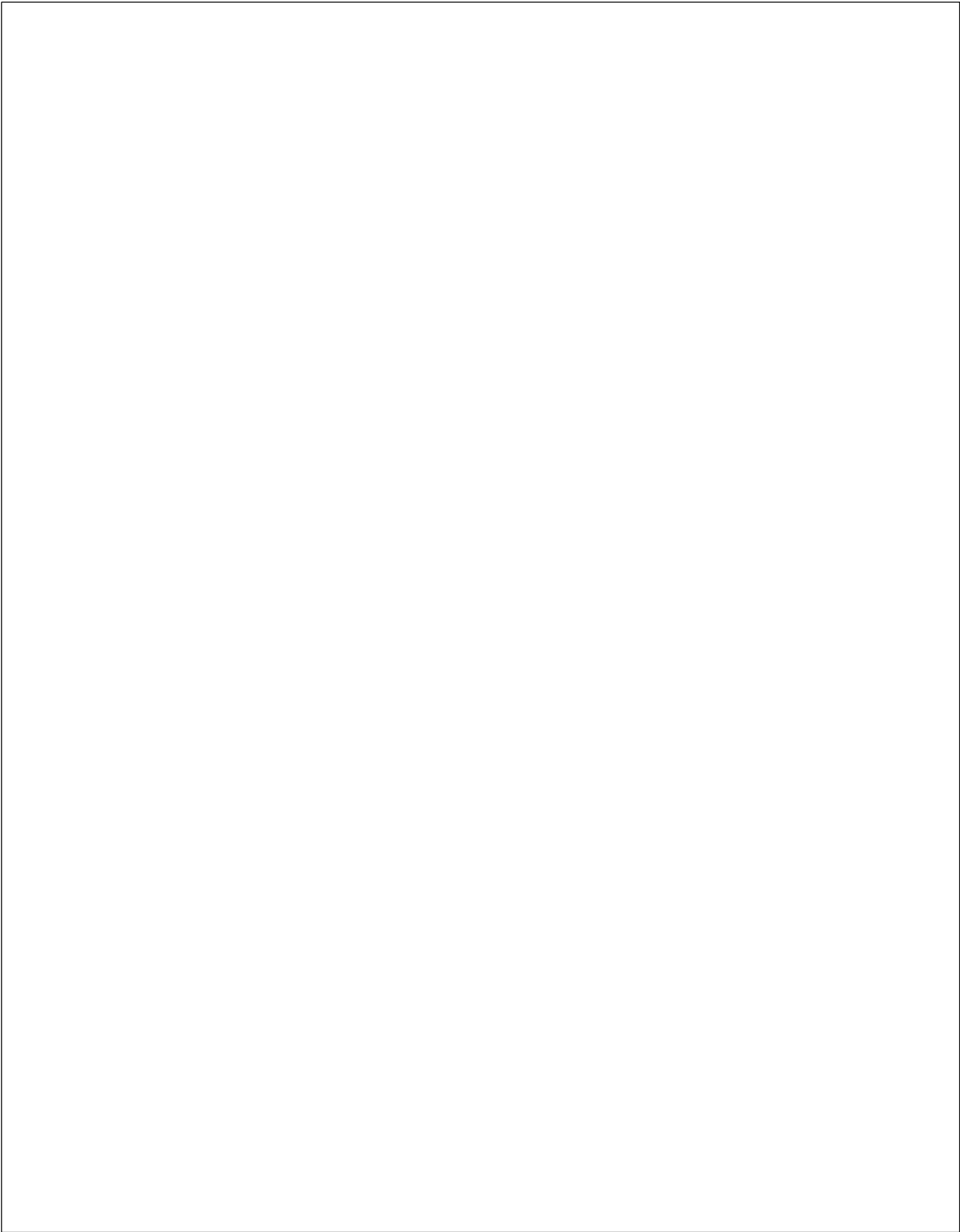

THE FOUNDER OF THE HOLY FAMILY BROTHERS AND SCHOOLS

France was experiencing the end of the revolutionary process and hostilities towards the Church had ceased in the country that was time Gabriel Taborin Poncet was born on November 1, 1799 in Belleydoux, diocese of Belley (France). As little boy he experienced the impact revolution. Slowly favourable environment for living religion with freedom was progressively expanding, as young man he helped the churches, young people and children of the villages as teacher, catchiest and liturgical animator.

In this historical framework, rebuilding parish life and valuing education as a means of human and Christian promotion, Brother Gabriel Taborin founded the Congregation of the Brothers of the Holy Family in 1835, later It was approved by Pope Gregoery XVI in Rome in 1841. His ideal of religious life and apostolic work arose from a deep faith that guided him in a constant prayer, to feel the beauty of the liturgy ad “to do all kind of good works” in favour of the church.

Brother Gabriel sent brothers to help in parishes, boarding schools and educational centres in neighbouring villages, in 1864 on 24th November, Brother Gabriel dies in the mother House at Belley (France). A mission lived by his still got spread all around the world. Pope John Paul II, on May 14, 1991, declared Brother Gabriel Taborin “Venerable”
